GRAND KNIGHT'S MESSAGE

Brothers and Friends,

As I sit down to write I am reflecting on the past few months and the simple fact I am so grateful at being able to do so after my lengthy stay in hospital. I am not sure of what to say other than thank you to

everybody for your well wishes, visits, all the offers of help, and most importantly your warm thoughts and prayers. They were felt and heard, thank you.

I want to share a personal experience with you. About a week, after I was admitted to the hospital my son James became sick as well with a bad cold and flu. James was feeling particularly bad that not only he could not come to see me in the Peterborough hospital, he didn't want to give me what he had. On one of our calls James was talking about needing something from the pharmacy and was too sick to go out. I told him that was fine if there was anything that he wanted he just had to ask, that I had a hundred brothers in Cobourg that would be pleased pick up something and bring it to him or help in any way possible. I was able to tell James this with absolute confidence, he just had to ask me, I could call one of the Knights. I said I have 100 brothers that would be happy to assist. As a parent who could not be there to help, it was an awful feeling, but the thought and confidence of knowing I could ask for assistance was truly a great sense of relief to me. It gave me a great sense of pride in being a knight to be able to tell James this.

As I reflect on this conversation with James and share this personal experience, I see that we learn at a young age that we do not want to impose on others. James, like most of us myself included do not like to ask for

help or assistance when we can use it. We do not want to bother someone else or to put him or her out. My point here to you, is, to ask when you can use some help whatever that it is. Understand that whom you ask might not be able to assist for any number of reasons but know that they will be able to help find the assistance needed. Brothers and friends please remember to reach out and ask when in need, remember that we are here for each other and want to help when there is a need for assistance.

Despite not having to go to work and having very little to do other than sleep and heal I feel out of the loop on the past few months. I would like to thank Brother Bob Hasiuk for stepping up and taking care of my responsibilities for the past two months. Thank you Bob!

Bingo Night

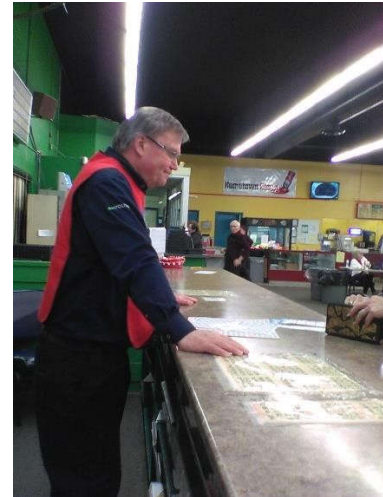
Brothers of Council 1970:
