Facts to Know About Long-Term Care Planning

November is National Long-Term Care Awareness Month. To mark the occasion, here are some interesting facts shared by the American Association for Long-Term Care Insurance.

- 1) North Americans are living longer, in large part due to advances in medical care and public health. Life expectancy for those reaching 65 was 20 years on average in 2019.
- 2) By 2030, one in five residents will be age 65 or older.
- 3) The number of people in need of long term support services (LTSS) is already at 14 million and expected to grow to 27 million by 2050.
- 4) Average out-of-pocket costs are \$140,000 for those individuals who utilize paid long term support services (LTSS). Roughly 17 percent will spend over \$100,000 on LTSS. Almost 9 percent will spend over \$250,000 on LTSS.
- 5) By 2040, the total prevalence of Alzheimer's disease and related dementias is expected to approximately double from 7.2 million to nearly 13 million, with 8.5 million women and 4.5 million men expected to develop dementia.
